

Report of FIT India Movement "Sundays on Cycle" dated 16/03/2025



High Discard Rate??- Need of the hour to understand (ISBTI-Gujarat Chapter)

Blood is a precious commodity and should never get wasted due to any cause. It has been observed that Discard of Blood Units is on Higher side in Gujarat compared to other states. To decrease the discard rate of blood, it is important to understand the whole chain of Blood Transfusion Services, starting from Blood Donation to Transfusion. By taking prophylactic steps, we can definitely make a difference in this direction.

At Blood Centre Level

- FIFO POLICY (First In, First Out)- The first collected unit should be used first to avoid expiry.
- TRANSFER OF NEAR EXPIRY UNITS- Transfer to the nearby Blood Centers or High Transfusion usage Hospitals.
- <u>COLD CHAIN MANAGEMENT-</u> Storage Temperature guidelines should be followed (for RBCs 2-6C, for Plasma -30C, For Platelets 22C)
- <u>COMPONENT SEPARATION-</u> Whole blood should be separated into components so that targeted component can be used. Red cells with additives like SAGM should be used to increase lifespan of RBCs.
- Quality Control-Stringent donor screening to be followed. Also, regular QC of components should be done to avoid discard due to QC failure.
- POWER SUPPLY- Generator facility for Power backup to avoid quality spoilage of individual component.
- REDUCE OVERSTOCKING- Maintain inventory as per the usage to prevent unnecessary wastage.
- STAFF TRAINING- educate staff on minimizing contamination and maintaining quality of each component.

At Clinician Level

- Myth on Expiry date- Blood units are absolutely safe to use till 12 midnight on the date of expiry after evaluating hemolysis in RBC unit.
- <u>ISSUE WHEN NEEDED -</u> Blood component should be demanded only when intending to transfuse and it should be Transfused as soon as possible to get best possible result.
- FRESH BLOOD- All blood unit or blood component has its expiry as per Drugs and Cosmetic Act and date is always mentioned on the unit. Till the



date and time of expiry that component can be safe to use so insisting on Fresh blood Unit should be avoided until any specific indication.

- <u>COLD CHAIN MAINTENANCE-</u> To ensure proper storage Temperature, after issue of blood components and while transport to bedside will prevent deterioration of blood component.
- OVER RESERVE OF UNITS Unnecessary reserve of blood components without any clinical indication should be watchful because this can lead to unnecessary shortage of blood for emergency patients who are actually in need.
- TRAINING & EDUCATION It is advisable to educate staff about storage Temp, shelf life & guidelines of Rational Use of Blood.
- PATIENT BLOOD MANAGEMENT- To optimize Hb level pre-surgery especially planned surgeries, use alternative measures whenever possible and restrict transfusion to clinical need.
- <u>COMMUNICATION</u> In case of cancellation of surgery or non-transfusion due to any reason, blood centre should be notified timely

At Donor Level.

- <u>SELF EXCLUSION-</u> Educating blood donor about deferral periods (recent infection, surgery, medication, travel or personal history) can prevent collection of blood that may later be discarded.
- TRANSPARENCY- being transparent about personal-Medical & Drug History as well as Sexual history with the Doctor should be there.
- ALTERNATE TESTING FACILITIES- Any Donor who is donating Blood, He/She is benefitted by the advantage of their own Blood Checkup (Blood Group, Hb, BP, HIV, HBsAg, HCV, Malaria, Syphilis) which is Mandatory to perform on any Blood unit before using for Transfusion.

At LayMan Level

- TRANSPORTATION- While transferring blood component from blood centre to Hospital, cold chain environment should be maintained.
- REGULAR/REPEAT BLOOD DONORS Donation at regular interval will ensure safety of blood and prevent unnecessary discard due to reactivity in testing.
- MOTIVATE TO DONATE- by regularly donating Blood & keeping your own self healthy. Rare Blood group donors can register themselves with Blood centre to recall them when necessary.

Let's join hands together & don't let a single unit of blood get wasted.

Case 3: Mrs Poonam Verma v/s Dr Ashwin Patel & Ors

This is also a landmark judgement involving medical negligence. The facts of the case are -> Mr Pramod Verma; husband of the petitioner was examined for fever by Dr. Ashwin Patel (Respondent); who was their family physician; at his residence. Dr Ashwin kept him on allopathic drugs for viral fever for 2 days. Thereafter, he was treated for typhoid fever as it was prevalent in the locality; following which his condition deteriorated, hence he was shifted to Sanjeevani Maternity and General Nursing Home under Dr Rajeev Warty for admission where he was treated for couple of days but he worsened and was ultimately transferred to Hinduja hospital in an unconscious state where after about four and a half hours of admission, he died. Mrs Poonam filed a petition initially with the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission for the negligence on part of the doctors in treating her husband but the Commission dismissed the petition which led to this appeal in the Supreme Court. The Issues were -> The eligibility of Dr Ashwin Patel (DHMS) to practice allopathic medicine without prerequisite qualifications and deviation from the usual code of conduct of medical professionals. She alleged negligence on part of the treating doctors which led to deterioration of the petitioner's husband's health and his unfortunate death. The court found that Dr Ashwin was a holder of Diploma in Homeopathic Medicine and Surgery (DHMS) awarded

by the Homeopathic Medical College, Anand, Gujarat and was registered as a Medical Practitioner; practised at a private nursing home in Bombay as a Chief Medical Officer and then shifted to private practice. He admitted that he was trained only in Homeopathy & not Allopathy. He had not studied Pharmacology related to Allopathic medications. A person who is registered under the Bombay Homeopathic Practitioners Act, 1959 can practice Homeopathy ONLY and is not allowed to practice allopathy. The court stated that a person who does not have knowledge of a particular System of Medicine but practices in that System is a Quack and a mere pretender to medical knowledge or skill. He trespassed into a prohibited field & was liable to be prosecuted under Section 15(3) of the Indian Medical Council Act. Where a person is guilty of Negligence per se, no further proof is needed. Dr Ashwin Patel started treatment of Mr Verma for Viral Fever and subsequently typhoid fever as it was —> "very much prevalent in the locality". Assuming that the patient would be suffering from it instead of confirming the diagnosis by pathological tests which would have positively established whether Pramod Verma was suffering from Typhoid or not. He claimed that he had advised blood investigations & urine test but they had not been done by the patient. There was no proof of any such advice in any of Dr Ashwin's filed prescriptions. The court stated that we cannot ignore the usual practice of almost all the Doctors that when they want pathological tests to be done, they advise in writing on a prescription. Admittedly, Respondent claimed that he had advised orally but had not done it in writing. This cannot be believed as this statement is contrary to the usual code of conduct of medical practitioners. A committee from AIIMS noted that the probable cause of death was infection leading to septicemia in background of unrecognized diabetes; intracranial

complications; fulminant course of disease leading to death despite usual management and treatment. Hence no charges were levied against other treating doctors; but Dr Ashwin was held liable. Dr Ashwin, having practised Allopathy, without being qualified in that system, was guilty of Negligence per se & therefore, the appeal against him has to be allowed in consonance with the maxim 'Sic Utere tuo ut alienum non loedas' (a person is held liable at law for the consequences of his negligence). A violation of Section 15(3) of the Indian medical Council Act was established against Dr Ashwin Patel. Monetary compensation was awarded as Mr Pramod Verma died a young death depriving his dependent family of the monetary security they were getting hence they were entitled under law to be compensated.

This case relied upon the Consumer Protection Act (1986) —> a patient who is a 'consumer'; within the meaning of the Act has to be awarded compensation for loss or injury suffered by him due to negligence of the Doctor by applying the same tests as are applied in an action for damages for negligence. The basis —> Indian Medical Association v/s VP Shantha case (1995). It also reiterated the significance of Negligence as a tort: 'the breach of a duty caused by omission to do something which a reasonable man would do; or doing something which a prudent and reasonable man would not do.' It also opened up a can of worms regarding need for more stringent guidelines allowing interplay of various allied healthcare branches with allopathy; which is still an ongoing issue at large.

Case 4: Mr Jaspal Singh v/s Postgraduate Institute of Medical **Education and**

Research, PGI Chandigarh

This is also a landmark judgement involving medical negligence. The facts of the case are -> Mrs Harjit Kaur (wife of

complainant) received accidental burns while making tea on the stove. She sustained 50% TBSA III burns involving both upper limbs, part of the trunk and most of both lower limbs. She was taken to DayaNand Medical College and Hospital, Ludhiana immediately where she responded well to the treatment but treatment there was expensive, so complainant decided to shift his wife to PGI for further treatment. Harjit Kaur was admitted in PGI, Chandigarh where Dr. Varun Kulshrestha, Senior Resident Doctor, Department of Plastic Surgery attended to her. The condition of Smt. Harjit Kaur started improving at PGI. On May 15, 1996, she was transfused A+ blood which was her actual blood group. On May 20, 1996, the patient was transfused B+ blood group in the afternoon although her blood group was A+. On the night of May 20, 1996, the urine of the patient was reddish like blood. As to her bad luck, on the next day, i.e., May 21, 1996 again one bottle of B+ blood group was transfused although her blood group was A+. Because of transfusion of mismatched blood, her condition became serious; her hemoglobin levels fell down to 5mg. and urea level went very high. Later on, it transpired that due to transfusion of mismatched blood, the kidney and liver of the patient got deranged. The complainant made a written complaint to the HOD of Plastic Surgery and an inquiry was conducted wherein wrong mismatched transfusion of the blood to the patient was found. Her condition started deteriorating day by day & she ultimately died on July 1, 1996. Complainants alleged that her death was caused due to the negligence of Dr. Varun Kulshrestha & the medical staff at PGI. Dr. Varun filed reply to the complaint stating that the patient was transfused wrong blood but due to the care exercised by him and the other nursing staff, the patient recovered from mismatched blood transfusion. He stated that she died of septicemia and not by mismatched blood transfusion. In respect of incompatible transfusions, it is stated that if blood of the wrong (incompatible) ABO blood group is transfused, a hemolytic transfusion reaction usually results, red cells are destroyed & there may be jaundice with hemoglobinemia & hemoglobinuria. Chills, fever and shock may occur. The patient in our case had no signs of septicemia. It was only after mismatched blood transfusion on two consecutive days, that she became anemic and her kidney and liver were deranged. Although she survived for about 40 days after mismatched transfusion but it cannot be said that there was no causal link between the mismatched transfusion of blood & her death. This is also a landmark judgement involving medical negligence. The facts of the case are -> Mrs Harjit Kaur (wife of complainant) received accidental burns while making tea on the stove. She sustained 50% TBSA III burns involving both upper limbs, part of the trunk and most of both lower limbs. She was taken to DayaNand Medical College and Hospital, Ludhiana immediately where she responded well to the treatment but treatment there was expensive, so complainant decided to shift his wife to PGI for further treatment. Harjit Kaur was admitted in PGI, Chandigarh where Dr. Varun Kulshrestha, Senior Resident Doctor, Department of Plastic Surgery attended to her. The condition of Smt. Harjit Kaur started improving at PGI. On May 15, 1996, she was transfused A+ blood which was her actual blood group. On May 20, 1996, the patient was transfused B+ blood group in the afternoon although her blood group was A+. On the night of May 20, 1996, the urine of the patient was reddish like blood. As to her bad luck, on the next day, i.e., May 21, 1996 again one bottle of B+ blood group was transfused although her blood group was A+. Because of transfusion of mismatched blood, her condition became serious; her hemoglobin levels fell down to 5mg, and urea level went very

high. Later on, it transpired that due to transfusion of mismatched blood, the kidney and liver of the patient got deranged. The complainant made a written complaint to the HOD of Plastic Surgery and an inquiry was conducted wherein wrong mismatched transfusion of the blood to the patient was found. Her condition started deteriorating day by day & she ultimately died on July 1, 1996. Complainants alleged that her death was caused due to the negligence of Dr. Varun Kulshrestha & the medical staff at PGI. Dr. Varun filed reply to the complaint stating that the patient was transfused wrong blood but due to the care exercised by him and the other nursing staff, the patient recovered from mismatched blood transfusion. He stated that she died of septicemia and not by mismatched blood transfusion. In respect of incompatible transfusions, it is stated that if blood of the wrong (incompatible) ABO blood group is transfused, a hemolytic transfusion reaction usually results, red cells are destroyed & there may be jaundice with hemoglobinemia & hemoglobinuria. Chills, fever and shock may occur. The patient in our case had no signs of septicemia. It was only after mismatched blood transfusion on two consecutive days, that she became anemic and her kidney and liver were deranged. Although she survived for about 40 days after mismatched transfusion but it cannot be said that there was no causal link between the mismatched transfusion of blood & her death.

Wrong blood transfusion is an error which no hospital/doctor exercising ordinary care would have made. Such an error is not an error of professional judgment but in the very nature of things a sure instance of medical negligence. The hospital's breach of duty in mismatched blood transfusion contributed to her death, if not wholly, but surely materially. Mismatched blood transfusion to a patient having sustained 50% burns by itself speaks of negligence.

The court stated that "Though septicemia has been written as the ultimate cause of death, the patient's health took a nose dive only after wrong blood was given to her and this is clearly negligence on the part of the Doctors of the Hospital which the appellants cannot disown or absolve themselves....". The institute and the doctors were held liable. It was a case of "Res Ipsa Loquitur" meaning the "The thing speaks for itself.

This case highlighted the doctrine of "Res Ipsa Loquitur" —> "The Thing Speaks for Itself".

Examples include ->

- Leaving swabs/instruments inside the patient's body
- Mismatched blood transfusion
- Operating on wrong patient / wrong body part
- Injury during surgery




