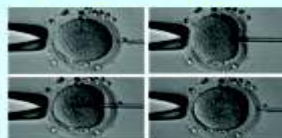

Collectively more than 2000 calls attended & all types of their queries were solved

Maximum callers had questions related to symptoms, disease, testing (modalities & their interpretations) & medicines they need to take. They were guided accordingly. By this helpline, we helped to remove panic and fear amongst them and instill awareness, strength to fight and also right scientific way to fight.

Many had questions regarding isolation - how many days of isolation required? & many did not understand the way of counting those days. The questions like isolation of multiple family members in same house testing positive / isolation of children were also common. Right information helped them to get back to their routine life without fear.

Many had queries regarding booster dose & process of getting booster. The queries regarding when to take dose of vaccine after being covid positive & which vaccine to take in booster were also answered.

Helpline also helped to remove many misinformation. Few thought if they got fever after

vaccine it could be because of vaccine; but, when they were asked to test covid many came positive. Many felt they got covid after vaccination. These misbelieves were clarified with scientific explanation. Many felt covishield is better than covaxin or other way round. Helpline helped them to understand the science of vaccine.

Many international travelers' call were common after getting positive reports just before travel. They did not know when to test again for travelling. This was the common policy issue for those travelling outside. Few had questions regarding retesting. Few were asked by offices or society to bring negative result before joining work. They were told to send the ICMR guidelines to office authorities to discontinue their wrong policy. Helpline helped to spread awareness, to reach out for vaccination and to understand many government policies in better way.

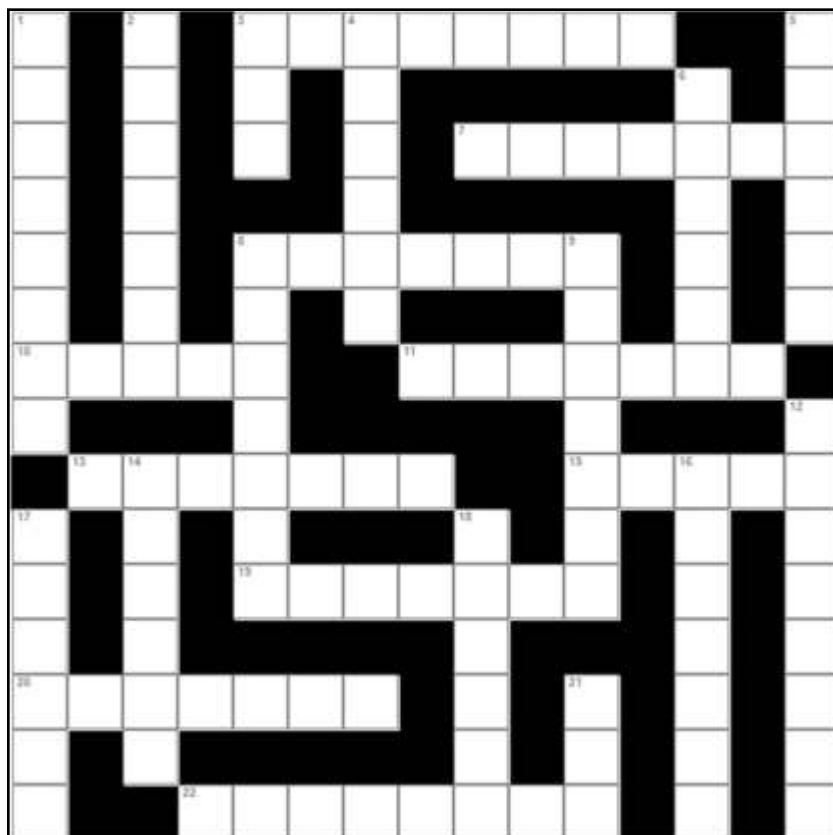
Report of spiritual event organized in association with Brahmakumaris Medical Wing, Ahmedabad.

NAT Tested blood - BENEFITS

Nucleic acid testing (NAT) is a molecular technique for screening blood donations to reduce the risk of transfusion transmitted infections (TTIs) in the recipients, thus providing an additional layer of blood safety.

❖ What is NAT (Nucleic Acid Tested) Blood?

NAT technique is highly sensitive and specific for viral nucleic acids. It is based on amplification of targeted regions of viral ribonucleic acid or deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) and detects them earlier than the other screening methods thus, narrowing the window period of Human Immunodeficiency virus (HIV), and Hepatitis B (HBV) and hepatitis C virus (HCV) infections

❖ Why NAT tested blood is required?

- Ensures patients safety (Negligible cost versus Minimal Risk to patients).
- To avoid medico-legal consequences for doctor due to post transfusion transmitted infections cases in patients (Negligible cost versus Safety



to doctors). There are many reported cases in India where such adverse events of transfusion have occurred and the Hospital has to give hefty compensation to the patients.

- If NAT tested blood is not available in city and not using it is not a crime, but if NAT tested blood is available in city and at a negligible cost then it is the duty to ask patient considering the negligible cost of NAT tested blood.
- Transfusion transmitted infections continue to be the biggest threat to the blood transfusion safety. Despite the advancements made in the serological testing of HBV, HCV and HIV, significant transfusion transmission of virus still remains.
- With high prevalence of HIV, HBV and HCV in India being 0.1-1%, 2-4% and 1-2% respectively; safe blood transfusion is a big challenge for the health care system.

❖ Comparison with Routine screening methods in India:



NAT is a highly sensitive and advanced technique which has reduced the window period of HBV to 10.34 days, HCV to 1.34 days and HIV to 2.93 days in comparison to ELISA (routinely screening method) where the window period ranges from weeks to months.

The average NAT yield in India as per statistical data is 1:800 which means one transfusion in 800 transfusions causes transfusion transmitted infection to patient due to window period blood donation not detected by routine screening method.

❖ **Processing charge for NAT tested Blood:**

The processing charge could have been restricted at very reasonable even for NAT tested blood now.
