## COVID-19 (coronavirus): Long-term effects

COVID-19 symptoms can sometimes persist for months. The virus can damage the lungs, heart and brain, which increases the risk of long-term health problems.

Most people who have coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) recover completely within a few weeks. But some people — even those who had mild versions of the disease — continue to experience symptoms after their initial recovery.

These people sometimes describe themselves as "long haulers" and the condition has been called post-COVID-19 syndrome or "long COVID-19."

Older people and people with many serious medical conditions are the most likely to experience lingering COVID-19 symptoms, but even young, otherwise healthy people can feel unwell for weeks to months after infection. The most common signs and symptoms that linger over time include:

- Fatigue
- Shortness of breath
- Cough
- Joint pain
- Chest pain

Other long-term signs and symptoms may include:

- Muscle pain or headache
- Fast or pounding heartbeat
- Loss of smell or taste
- Memory, concentration or sleep problems
- Rash or hair loss

Organ damage caused by COVID-19

Although COVID-19 is seen as a disease that primarily affects the lungs, it can damage many other organs as well. This organ damage may increase the risk of long-term health problems. Organs that may be affected by COVID-19 include:

**Heart :** Imaging tests taken months after recovery from COVID-19 have shown lasting damage to the heart muscle, even in people who experienced only mild COVID-19 symptoms. This may increase the risk of heart failure or other heart complications in the future.

**Lungs :** The type of pneumonia often associated with COVID-19 can cause long-standing damage to the tiny air sacs (alveoli) in the lungs. The resulting scar tissue can lead to long-term breathing problems.

**Brain :** Even in young people, COVID-19 can cause strokes, seizures and Guillain-Barre syndrome — a condition that causes temporary paralysis. COVID-19 may also increase the risk of developing Parkinson's disease and Alzheimer's disease.

Blood clots and blood vessel problems :

COVID-19 can make blood cells more likely to clump up and form clots. While large clots can cause heart attacks and strokes, much of the heart damage caused by COVID-19 is believed to stem from very small clots that block tiny blood vessels (capillaries) in the heart muscle.

Other parts of the body affected by blood clots include the lungs, legs, liver and kidneys. COVID-19 can also weaken blood vessels and cause them to leak, which contributes to potentially long-lasting problems with the liver and kidneys.

Problems with mood and fatigue :

People who have severe symptoms of COVID-19 often have to

be treated in a hospital's intensive care unit, with mechanical assistance such as ventilators to breathe. Simply surviving this experience can make a person more likely to later develop post-traumatic stress syndrome, depression and anxiety.

Because it's difficult to predict long-term outcomes from the new COVID-19 virus, scientists are looking at the long-term effects seen in related viruses, such as the virus that causes severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS).

Many people who have recovered from SARS have gone on to develop chronic fatigue syndrome, a complex disorder characterized by extreme fatigue that worsens with physical or mental activity, but doesn't improve with rest. The same may be true for people who have had COVID-19.

#### Many long-term COVID-19 effects still unknown

Much is still unknown about how COVID-19 will affect people over time. However, researchers recommend that doctors closely monitor people who have had COVID-19 to see how their organs are functioning after recovery.

Many large medical centers are opening specialized clinics to provide care for people who have persistent symptoms or related illnesses after they recover from COVID-19.

It's important to remember that most people who have COVID-19 recover quickly. But the potentially long-lasting problems from COVID-19 make it even more important to reduce the spread of the disease by following precautions such as wearing masks, avoiding crowds and keeping hands clean.

# Newer innovations in Cardiology

The field of cardiology has progressed greatly over last 40 years, since the success of percutaneous angioplasty done by Dr. Andrea Gruntzig. In the last decade, there has been tremendous growth in structural interventions. There is a fundamental difference in the approach of a surgeon and an interventionists as the surgeon can actually see the heart in three dimension whereas an interventionist depends on pattern recognition and 2D imaging. The whole scenario is akin to walking in broad daylight for a surgeon versus roaming in dark alley for an interventionist.

However we describe a few innovations which have catapulted the field of structural cardiology.

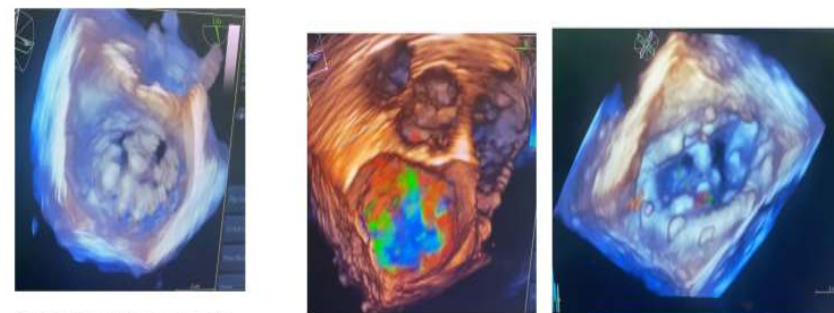
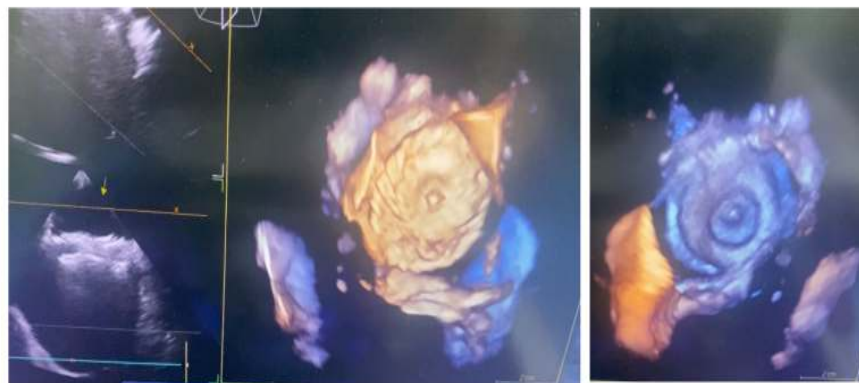
There have been great advances in 3D and Fusion imaging and 3D printing has also arrived in a big way and is helping the cardiologist in understanding and planning procedures.

## 3D Echocardiography:

This modality has helped greatly in the emergence of structural intervention. 3D Echocardiography is useful in image guidance during structural procedures like ASD closure, paravalvular leak, Mitra-clip and assisting during surgical procedures.

The newer modalities in 3D help in easy real lifelike identification of lesions and assist in procedures.

## 3 D echo cardio gram for ASD Closure

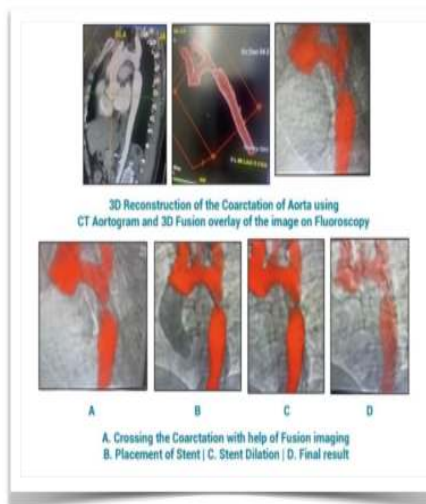


**3D echocardiography of Barlow valve pre surgery and after repair**

## Fusion imaging .

Fusion imaging using either echocardiography, rotational angiography or CT , MRI images can be used to guide in complex intervention like coarctation of aorta, TAVR, paravalvar leak, and conduit stenting.

We have used fusion imaging in a case of coarctation for stenting and during TAVR to see for coronary status.



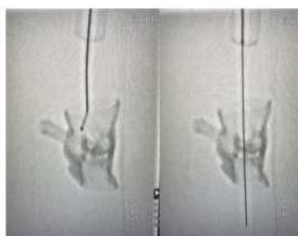
CT fusion imaging over-layed on fluoroscopy screen to show that the left coronary artery is away from the TAVR valve

### 3D printing

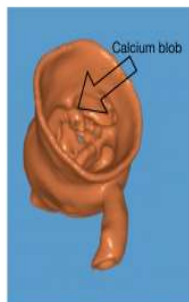
Additive technologies like 3D printing have ushered in a new era in the structural procedures.

3D printing can help in understanding the anatomy of interest as well as plan the procedure. It can also be used to print a pathological model of interest and learn a procedure through simulation.

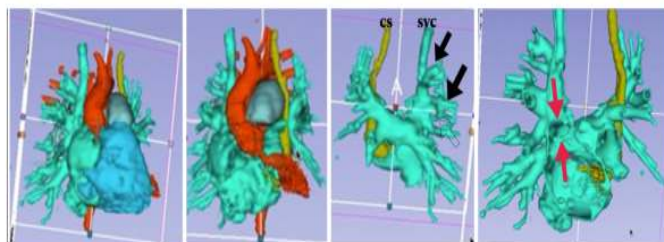
We have used the same to learn aortic valve crossing and ductal stenting. We have used virtual imaging with segmenting a CT Cardiac image to help the surgeon understand extent of the disease.

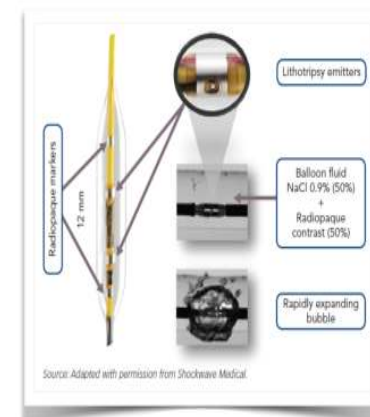
### SHOCK WAVE INTRAVASCULAR LITHOTRIPSY
