



ORGAN DONATION

What is organ donation?

It is when a person allows an organ of their own to be removed and transplanted to another person, legally, either by consent while the donor is alive or dead with the assent of the next of kin.

Donation may be for research or, more commonly, healthy transplantable organs and tissues may be donated to be transplanted into another person

The most common organs transplanted are kidney, heart, liver, pancreas, lungs, bone, bone marrow, skin and cornea.

History - The first living organ donor in a successful transplant was Ronald Lee Herrick (1931–2010), who donated a kidney to his identical twin brother in 1954.^[10] The lead surgeon, Joseph Murray, won the Nobel Prize in 1990.

The youngest organ donor was a baby with anencephaly, born in 2015, who lived for only 100 minutes and donated his kidneys to an adult with renal failure.^[11] The oldest known organ donor was a 107-year-old Scottish woman, whose corneas were donated after her death in 2016.^[12] The oldest known organ donor for an internal organ was a 92-year-old Texas man, whose family chose to donate his liver after he died of a brain hemorrhage.¹

Kidney transplants in India first started in the 1970s and since that time, India has been a leading country in this field on the Asian sub-continent. The evolutionary history of transplants in the last four decades has witnessed a different facet of transplant emerging in each decade. The first cadaveric kidney transplant in India was undertaken in Mumbai in 1965.

Major Organs and tissue donation

Thoracic organs – Heart(deceased donor), Lungs(deceased donor).

Abdominal Organs – Kidney(deceased donor and living donor), Liver(deceased donor and living donor), pancreas(deceased donor and living donor), stomach(deceased donor), Intestine(deceased donor),

Tissue and body fluids – cornea(deceased donor), bone marrow(deceased donor), heart valves(deceased donor and xenograft), bones(deceased donor and living donor).

Legalization of Organ donation , Indian and Global perspectives – Various countries have developed their own legal process for organ donation. One of the main perspectives in organ donation is **consent**. There are two types of consents regarding organ donation; EXPLICIT CONSENT & PRESUMED CONSENT. Explicit consent consists of the donor giving direct consent through proper registration depending on the country. The second consent process is presumed consent, which does not need direct consent from the donor or the next of kin. Recent advances in medical science has led to drastic demand of the organ donation.

Basically two types of policy have been accepted in global society; 1) opt-out policy and 2) opt-in policy.

Opt in are those who have given explicit consent are donors. Opt out are those who has not refused consent to donate are donors.

Various countries practicing “opt in “ are United States Of America, United Kingdom, India, European Union, Australia, South Africa. Countries practicing “opt out “ are Turkey , Russian Federation.

Spain has the highest donor rate in the world at 46.9 per million people followed by Portugal 34.0 per million.

In India most of the transplant are living related or unrelated transplant. To promote organ donation after brain death and to curb organ commerce central government of India enacted a law called “The Transplantation of Human Organs Act” in 1994 that brought a significant change in organ donation and transplant scene in India. Deceased donation after brain death have slowly started happening in India. As per data available for year 2013-2014 total number of 313 donor turned out and total 852 different organs were available from them for transplant, this numbers are constantly increasing but central and state government efforts and with the help of various NGOs. Mohan foundation primarily working in the state of Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh has done a pioneer contribution in setting up the organ sharing network. As a result, retrieval of 1033 organs and tissue were facilitated in these two states.

Various other programs are going on at different levels promoting organ donation in India such as; jeevandan programme in Andhra Pradesh, Zonal Coordination committee of Karnataka for Transplant, mrithasanjeevani kerala network for organ sharing, Navjeevan network of organ sharing Rajasthan, Shatayu an NGO by Govindbhai C.Patel foundation Cadaveric Transplant Programme of Tamil Nadu.

An online organ sharing registry is maintained for deceased donation and transplant by the Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry Of Health And Family Welfare, Government of India at New Delhi.

In India states such as Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Kerala and Delhi are the highest contributors for organ donation.

WHO CAN DONATE – All people should consider themselves a potential organ donor and tissue donors regardless of age, health, race, or ethnicity. No one is too old or too young for deceased donor and most of the religion support donation.

Even with illness or health condition you may be able to donate your organs or tissues upon death. If the situation arises upon death, doctors examine your organs and determine whether they are suitable for donation. **Few condition which prevent from organ donation are active cancers, HIV Positivity, HCV and Hepatitis B positivity and some immunological diseases.**

Newborn and a old man in his 90's can be a donor as health of your organ counts more than your age.

Most of the donors are living donors, deceased donors and cadaveric donors. Living donors most frequently donate their kidney, part of liver while the deceased donors donate their liver, lungs, pancreas, intestine. Cadaveric donors are donors of heart valves and cornea.

ORGAN PRESERVATION- Organ preservation is the supply line for organ transplantation. Currently the liver pancreas and kidney can be successfully preserved for up to two days by flushing the organ with the UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN organ preservation solution and storing them at hypothermia (0-5 degree C), the solution contains impermeant agents such as lacto bionic acid, raffinose, hydroxyethyl starch that prevent the cells from swelling during cold ischemic storage. In addition it also contains glutathione and adenosine agent that stimulates recovery of normal metabolism upon reperfusion by augmenting the antioxidant capacity of the organs or by stimulating high energy phosphate generation upon reperfusion.

GREEN CORRIDOR- It is demarcated, cleared out special road and air route created for an ambulance that enables harvested organs meant for transplant to reach the destined hospital. It is a special corridor without any stoppage which ensures that, during transit, organs arrive at its specialized and specific destination within the

shortest possible time. The prime objective of creation of these green corridors has arisen from the fact that organs have a short preservation time; henceforth, within few hours the entire process, right from harvesting interinstitutional transport and final transplantation surgery must be completed.

The time span between recovering organs and Transplant-

Lungs(4-6hours),	Heart(4-6hours),	Liver(24hours),	Pancreas(24hours)
Kidney(72hours),	cornea(14days),	Bone(5years),	Skin(5years).

How the organs are allocated based on ABO Blood type & HLA Grouping, Medical Urgency, Time on the waiting list and Geographic locations.

COMPLICATIONS OF ORGAN TRANSPLANT.

Transplant rejection manifest in three forms, * Hyperacute *Acute *Chronic. Hyperacute rejection is immediate and occurs in minutes and hours and requires explantation. Acute rejection occurs in one week to one month after transplant. It occurs because of T cytotoxic lymphocytes attack organs. Chronic rejection occurs over months to years mostly in lungs transplant.

Immunosuppressive therapy is given to recipient patients to suppress cytotoxic T cells and helper T cells. This therapy makes the recipient exposed to number of complications and infections. It leads to nephrotoxicity, increased risk of opportunistic infections, lymphoma, hepatotoxicity, neutropenia, diarrhea, vomiting, vitamin deficiency.

World organ donation day 13th August.
