3. Chairpersons will strictly adhere to the allotted time of 10 minutes
4. Only the presenting author may respond to questions from the floor or the chair.
5. Students must report to the hall 02 hours in advance to load the presentation
6. Students must stick to the timing allotted to them
7. Presenters are advised to take note of the following:
 - a. Stick to the point
 - b. Concentrate on the data being presented and their interpretation
8. All oral presentations and poster presentation will be as a PowerPoint and should be loaded in the respective halls. Personal Laptops are not allowed for presentation.
