



THE GIFT OF LIFE- ONE BLOOD DONATION SAVES 3

How fascinating it seems that one blood donation saves 3 lives. Often blood donors visiting the blood donation camp or blood centre are horrified looking at 3 or 4 blood bags attached to the needle and ask "HOW MANY BAGS ARE YOU **GOING TO FILL?"**

Brief about how one blood donation saves 3 lives:

Before the advent of componentization therapy, the blood was collected in glass bottles and was being issued for transfusion. Later, switching from glass bottles to blood bags took place.

Moreover, blood bags triple/quadruple system (interconnected 2-3 blood bags) were introduced which brought a revolution in blood transfusion services. It led to component therapy approach and rational use of blood and blood components were made by which one blood donation can save 3 lives.

The whole blood which is a mixture of cells, colloids and crystalloids can be separated into different blood components namely packed red blood cell (PRBC) concentrate, platelet concentrate (PC), fresh frozen plasma (FFP) and cryoprecipitate.

As different blood components have different relative density, sediment rate and size they can be separated when centrifugal force is applied.

The blood components prepared from one unit of whole blood are:

- 1. Packed red blood cells
- 2. Fresh frozen plasma or Cryo poor plasma
- 3. Platelet concentrate
- 4. Cryoprecipitate

Each blood component is used for a different indication; thus, the component separation has maximized the utility of one whole blood unit.

Different components need different storage conditions and temperature requirements for therapeutic efficacy.

Blood products are modified as Leucoreduced/leucodepleted products, irradiated products, volume reduced products, saline washed products, and pathogen inactivated products as per the indication for use in special cases.

New researches in red cell cultures and blood substitutes herald new era in blood banking.

Component Collection by Apheresis Procedure:

Apheresis is a procedure where required single or more than one component is collected and the rest of blood components are returned to the donor.

The working principle of apheresis equipment is by centrifugation (different specific gravity). In this method, fixed quantity of blood is collected in a bolus called as Extracorporeal volume (ECV) and the required component (e.g. Platelets) is separated and collected in the collection bag and the other components (e.g. red blood cells, leucocytes and plasma) are returned back to the donor.

The components that can be collected by Apheresis in India are:

- Platelets
- 2. Plasma (only in case of COVID-19 Convalescent Plasma)
- 3. Granulocytes
- Peripheral stem cells

How to refer a patient for Kidney transplant?: A Physician's guide

Introduction

Chronic kidney disease (CKD) is associated with high rates of morbidity and increasing rates of mortality worldwide.

Kidney transplant (KT) is the preferred form of kidney replacement therapy(KRT) for suitable patients as data shows that it improves the survival and quality of life compared to dialysis patients; that too at lower cost in the longer term. Demand for transplantable kidneys exceeds supply and thus candidacy for deceased donor transplantation needs careful evaluation.

Initiation of the transplant evaluation process depends on the patient's subjective well-being, underlying kidney disease and rate of glomerular filtration rate (GFR) loss; number and severity of comorbid conditions; and the anticipated need for specialized testing and immunological evaluation. This article addresses physicians dealing with CKD patients about knowledge of candidacy for transplant.

When to refer?

All CKD patients not on dialysis should be informed, educated and considered for kidney transplant evaluation at CKD stage G4 and G5 or at least 6 to 12 months before anticipated dialysis initiation to facilitate identification/work-up of living donors and plan for possible preemptive transplantation.

- Patients with advanced CKD who are expected to reach the stage of needing dialysis have the right to be informed of all available treatment options, including transplantation.
- Patients already on regular dialysis when medically stable and kidney failure deemed irreversible.

When not to refer?

CKD patients with following conditions should be precluded from kidney transplant evaluation.

- Plasma cell dyscresias, not adequately treated
- Progressive central neurodegenerative disease
- Severe irreversible obstructive or restrictive lung disease
- Severe uncorrectable and symptomatic cardiac disease that is deemed by a cardiologist
- Decompensated Cirrhosis of liver (may need combined liverkidney transplant)

Types of transplant donors:

- Living related donors: blood relatives of the recipient up to the 4th degree of consanguinity, spouses
- Living non-related donors: like friends.
- Deceased (cadaver) donors: from victims of brain death.
- In India, registration for deceased grafts can only be done after 3 months of regular dialysis treatment.

Pre-emptive transplant:

- Kidney transplantation may be done before the initiation of maintenance dialysis in CKD Stage 5 patient is called a preemptive KT.
- When a live donor is available or where pre-emptive deceased donor transplantation is possible, cases should proceed when the eGFR is <10 ml/min/1.73 m2 (10 to 15ml/min/1.73 m2 in pediatrics).
- The advantages of preemptive transplant are distinct due to avoidance of complications and cost dialysis
- It is also associated for better graft survival than patients transplanted after initiating the dialysis.

Within it reside both the living entity and the Supreme Lord, who are called ksetra-jna, the knowers of the field. Jnana, knowledge, means understanding of the body and its knowers. Knowledge involves qualities such as humility, nonviolence, tolerance, cleanliness, self-control, absence of false ego, and even — mindedness amid pleasant and unpleasant events. 	 The two purusas, or enjoyers, are the living entity and the Super soul. A person who can see that the individual soul and the Super soul remain unchanged throughout various types of material bodies they successfully inhabit and is said to possess the vision of eternity. By understanding the difference between the body and the knower of the body, and by understanding the process of liberation from material bondage, one reaches the supreme goal.

- The mode of ignorance means delusion. It fosters madness, indolence, laziness, and foolishness. If one dies in the mode of ignorance, he has to take birth in the animal kingdom or the hellish worlds.
- A person who transcends the three modes is steady in his behavior, aloof from the temporary material body, and equally disposed towards friends and enemies. Such transcendental qualities can be achieved by full engagement in devotional service.

Chapter 15: Puru? hottama Yoga

- The "tree" of this material world is but a reflection of the real "tree", the spiritual world.
- Just as a tree's reflection is situated on water, the material reflection of the spiritual world is situated on desire, and no one knows where it begins or ends.
- This reflected tree is nourished by the three modes of material nature. Its leaves are the Vedic hymns, and its twigs are the objects of the senses. One who wants to disentangle himself from this tree must cut it down with the weapon of detachment and seek shelter of the Supreme Lord.

Chapter 15 - Give priority to Divinity.

- Krishna explains how we are caught in the mysterious nature of cycle of death & rebirth in this material world.
- He compares life to the huge,many branched,well rooted Peepal tree which is not easily destructible.
- The first step is to develop detachment, freedom from reaction towards pairs of opposites, pride, sorrow etc & to be free from worldly pursuits.
- Having withdrawn mind from worldly desires, one should seek& give priority to Divinity(Brahman).
- Everyone in this world is fallible, but in the spiritual world everyone is infallible. And beyond all others is the Supreme Person, Krishna.

Chapter 16: Being good is a reward.

• In this Lord Krishna explains which types of human traits are divine and

- divine and the demoniac, are endowed with different qualities.
- Godly men like Arjuna possess the godly qualities: charity, self-control, gentleness, modesty, forgiveness, cleanliness, austerity, simplicity, nonviolence, truthfulness, tranquility, fearlessness, freedom from anger, cultivation of spiritual knowledge, aversion to fault-finding, compassion for all living beings, freedom from covetousness, and steady determination.
- Demoniac qualities such as pride, anger, envy, harshness, arrogance, ignorance, Impudence, uncleanliness, and improper behavior bind people in a network of illusion that makes them take birth again and again in demoniac species of life. Unable to approach Krishna, the demoniac gradually sink down to hell.

- Two kinds of action regulated and unregulated—yield different results.
- A person who discards scriptural injunctions attains neither perfection, nor happiness, nor the supreme destination.
- People regulated by scripture understand what duty is and what is not. They gradually attain the supreme destination by performing acts conducive to self–realization.

Chapter 17: ŚhraddhāTrayaVibhāga Yoga

- Arjuna asks. "what mode of nature governs those who do not follow the principles of scripture but worship according to their own imagination?"
- In reply, Krishna analyzes the different kinds of faith, food, charity, austerity, sacrifice, and penance that mark the different modes of material nature.
- The three words "om tat sat" are symbolic representations of the Supreme Absolute Truth.
- Om indicates the Supreme, tat is used for getting free from material entanglement, and sat indicates that the Absolute Truth is the objective of devotional service.
- Any sacrifice, charity, or penance performed without faith in the Supreme is called asat, impermanent.

Chapter 17: Divisions of faith (Choosing right over the pleasant is a sign of nower)

- This chapter explains the power of faith.
- Krishna explains the power of choosing right over the pleasant by acquiring knowledge and living life as a Satvic.
- He discusses significance of mantra"Om tat sat". Meaning "The supreme Absolute Truth" or "All that is.". 'Sat' has many meanings like truth, existence, goodness, good action & steadfastness.
- In essence while choosing right over pleasant the utterance of this mantra will sanctify scriptural actions and make one Satvic.

Chapter 18: Mok?haSanyasa Yoga

- Arjuna asks Krishna about the purpose of tyaga (renunciation) and sannyasa (the renounced order of life).
- One attains perfection by doing one's own work, not another's, as prescribed duties are never affected by sinful reactions. Thus one should work as a matter of duty, without attachment or expectation of result.
 One should never give up one's duty.
- The highest platform of self-realization is pure devotional service to Krishna. Accordingly, Krishna advises Arjuna to always depend on Him, work under His protection, and be conscious of Him. If Arjuna refuses to fight for Krishna, he will still be dragged into warfare as it is his nature as a ksatriya to fight. Nonetheless, he is free to decide what he wants to do.
- By Krishna's grace, Arjuna's illusion and doubt vanish, and he chooses to fight according to Krishna's directions.

Chapter 18: Conclusion: The Perfection of Renunciation

- The Bhagavad Gita teaches us the nature of the true self. Also, it teaches about spirituality.
- Krishna teaches us the ways of life or the art of living through the Bhagavad Gita. His teaching related to love, action, food, meditation, and deeds are incredible.
- Krishna explains, renunciation does not mean abandoning the duties of every day life & becoming a recluse to live a life of an Ascetic, neither does it mean living with indifference to the world & its affairs.
