Dr Jitendra N. Patel



- Dr Jitendra N. Patel, borne on 11th August, 1965, is a name which requires no introduction in the medical fraternity. He completed his graduation study from M.P.Shah Medical College, Jamnagar in 1987 and post-graduation in MD (Anaesthesia) from B. J. Medical College, Ahmedabad in 1991. He is a renowned practitioner Anaesthetist Ahmedabad since 1992.
- Apart from his private professional occupancy, he has remained enthusiastically available for the benefit of the medico fraternity and association activities. He graced the presidency of Ahmedabad Medical Association in 2009-10. Before the president-ship he has rendered his selfless services for the association in all capacities including the Treasurer, Secretary, Joint Secretary, Managing Committee member etc. from time to time. He also served as the Secretary of Indian Medical Association Gujarat State Branch from 2013-16. He was unanimously elected as the President of Ahmedabad branch of Indian Society of Anaesthesiology. Previously he had held the post of Convener of Academy of Medical Speciality too and presently he is the Secretary of Professional Protection Scheme of IMA.
- However, his service to the society needs no formal office-bearing anytime anywhere. This can be seen from the phenomenal work he carries out during honorary service as an anaesthetic doctor at Karuna Trust. He holds a distinguished achievement of 50 times blood donation. The first blood donation camp at GMDC was also organised during his presidency. He has been organising blood donation camp at his society for last 14 years in association with Keval foundation and collected more than 6000 blood bottles through this campaign. Not stopping at blood donation, he is also the organ donor.
- Last but not the least; he is the founder of Creator Anaesthesia Pvt. Ltd his
 dream venture established at Ahmedabad. Other than medical professionalism,
 he is providing yeoman service to the society by operating Shehnai Matrimonial
 service dedicated to eligible highly qualified professional youth of the day.

DR. B. N. MEHTA ORATION AWARD 2023

Dr. Abhijat C. Sheth



- Dr. Abhijat Sheth has qualified as cardiothoracic surgeon from India in 1994. He worked as an Assistant Professor in Cardiothoracic Surgery until 1998 at NHL Municipal Medical College, Ahmedabad. He went to UK in 1998 and worked in the Cardiothoracic Surgery department at Freeman Hospital, Newcastle upon Tyne. He obtained his FRCS (Glasgow) in General Surgery in 2000. From 2001 to 2010 he has worked in the Cardiothoracic Department of St George's Hospital NHS Trust, London. He has published more than 20 peer reviewed publications in prestigious journals like Annals of Thoracic Surgery, 40 abstract/oral conference presentations at the British Thoracic Society, European Respiratory Society and American Thoracic Society. His major research and publications are with the large airway interventions and Sildenafil therapy for patients with pulmonary hypertension. Since 2010 he is working with the Apollo Hospitals, Ahmedabad as a Medical Director. He also did MBA (Health Executive) from Keele University, Manchester.
- In June 2016 the Government of India has nominated him as the President of the National Board of Examination in Medical Science (NBEMS). The NBEMS regulates all India PG entrance examinations and conducts DNB (Diplomate of National Board) PG courses in India. He is nominated as governing board member of NABH by the quality council of India from April 2019. He was re-nominated as President of NBEMS in 2021. He also represents NBEMS as ex officio members in government and education institutions.

A mobile eyecare unit enables this project to provide Eyecare services at people's doorstep, especially those who live in rural areas. Project Disha has completed more than 25 comprehensive eye screening camps, more than 7500 patients assessed, more than 1050 eye surgeries performed, Eye check-up camps are held at more than 19 schools (in both Rural and Urban areas) and conducted eyesight checkups for more than 8950 students till date. In addition to her clinical work, she has taken on leadership roles within the healthcare industry. She has worked to implement innovative and effective policies and programs that have improved patient outcomes and increased access to care.
- She has received Dr C. T. Thakar Award for Young Doctors by IMA at Prayagraj, UP in December 2022. She also received a special mention with an article titled "Dr Anuja Desai: Leading Ophthalmologist with the Vision to provide affordable eye-care for all" in the Brand Connect Section of Forbes India Magazine, Feb 11, 2022 edition. Dr. GIRISHCHANDRA SHAH Octogenarian Award For the outstanding services to medicine & social services

Dr. Mahesh R. Desai



- Dr Mahesh R. Desai is a graduate of B.J. Medical College under the auspices of Pune University. He pursued his post graduation (MS) studies from the same Alma Mater. Trained in Urology, he was a recipient of the Fellowship of the Royal Colleges of Surgeons of London and Edinburgh (FRCS) in 1973. A decade later, he took over as the Chairman of the Department of Urology at Muljibhai Patel Urological Hospital (1983 - June, 2010), following which he served the Hospital as its Medical Director (June, 2010 - August, 2016). He now sits as the Managing Trustee of MPUH and Honorary Managing Director of Muljibhai Patel Society for Research in Nephro-Urology (February, 2001) and the Director of the Jayaramdas Patel Academic Center.
- A master of the most modern treatment for the stone disease, he is acclaimed for the development of modern innovative techniques in Percutaenous Nephrolithotrispy (PCNL), Ureteroscopy and ESWL. He has performed over 14000 PCNL, close to the largest series across the globe. He pioneered the service of kidney transplantation in Gujarat, along with expanding the use of ultrasound in Urology. It was in the year 1980 that Dr. Desai performed his first ever kidney transplant and since then, 3505 Renal Transplants have been performed at MPUH. Apart from being a world-class surgeon, Dr. Desai has successfully organized several conferences and workshops across the country. He led an epidemiological survey for prostatic diseases in the ageing male population, in Kheda / Charotar district of Gujarat. To this day, he has conducted 245 workshops, published 255 scientific papers in national and international journals and contributed to over 43 books. Under his guidance, the institute has also produced over 750 scientific papers which have been presented at various national and international seminars and conferences.
- Dr. Desai is an awardee of the prestigious Dr. B.C. Roy National Award (2000) in "Recognition of the best talents in encouraging the development of specialities in different branches of Medicine" by the President of India.
- Bangladesh Urological Association (BAUS) conducted inaugural Dr. Mahesh Desai Urolithiasis Course at Dhaka, Bangladesh on 11th & 12th March, 2017 and awarded BAUS Gold Medal to Dr. Mahesh Desai.
- Along with his direct contribution to the Endourology Society, Dr. Desai has also served the society as a teacher and mentor to over 70 students who have

trained in Urology under his guidance. As Director of Jayramdas Patel Academic Centre, he has inculcated the motto of Institute "Enter to Learn and Exit to Serve" in the minds of young trainee and experienced alumni. MPUH has been recognized as an Endourology training center and has produced 10 Endourology fellows till date, many of whom have published prize-winning

- Dr. Mahesh Desai has been ranked in the top 10 best doctors in the world for stone management and Muljibhai Patel Urological Hospital is also ranked as Top 10 best Hospital in the world for stone management by "Expertscapes Leaders in Kidney Calculi" in December, 2018. Dr. Desai is awarded "White Coat Awards" for Medical Pioneers by Times of India on 24th March, 2019. He was also awarded Gujarat Healthcare Leadership Awards 2020.

Table 4. To-Do List for a Comprehensive Approach to Diabetes-related **Foot Infection Care**

Surgical debridement: If present, drain deep purulence and excise necrotic tissue. Assess risk of amputation using clinically validated criteria (WIfI). If elevated, request surgical evaluation and risk-benefit/shared

Peripheral artery disease: Obtain relevant vascular studies (eq. toe pressure measurements); request vascular surgery evaluation if patient is likely to benefit from revascularization (ie, by Society for Vascular Surgery's WIff (Wound, Ischemia, Foot Infection) classification system Wlfl classification)

Antibiotic therapy: Once patient is stabilized and has responded to initial antimicrobial therapy, select an appropriate oral (or IV) definitive antimicrobial regimen, with considerations including:

- . Results of deep tissue cultures or the local epidemiology and antibiogram if cultures are not available
- Duration appropriate to the degree of infection and surgical management provided
- Social factors, including the ability to adhere to the regimen (eg, affordability, pill burden, ability to store and administer IV antibiotics, and travel to infusion centers) and whether giving IV antibiotic therapy inpatient or via skilled nursing facility facilitates access to other needed care (eg, wound care)

Offloading: Provide the patient with either a non-removable device (eg. total contact cast) or removable device (ie, surgical boot) to provide mechanical offloading of the diabetes-related foot wound; consider surgical offloading referral for select patients who do not heal with mechanical devices

Waund care: Secure longitudinal outpatient follow up with a wound care specialist who can provide serial assessment, debridement, and appropriate dressings or negative pressure wound therapy. Ensure the patient has access to adequate wound care supplies upon discharge and at each tollow-up visit

Glycemic control: Initiate or intensity diabetes treatment to achieve the HbA1c. goal to optimize wound healing:

 The Hb∆1c goal for most adults is <7% (comparable continuous glucose) monitoring targets are time in range >70% with time below range <4%). Higher or lower glycemic targets may be appropriate based on the individual's comorbidities and risk of hypoglycemia

Concurrent foot pathelogy: Identify and address other conditions that provide a bacterial portal of entry into the foot or otherwise predispose to infection:

- Treat onychomycosis and tinea pedis if present
- Offer compression garments and recommend leg elevation if venous stasis is present and degree of peripheral arterial disease allows
- · Recommend daily moisturizer to areas of dry, cracked skin
- Arrange longitudinal follow-up every 3 months, preferably by a podiatrist, for secondary prevention and early detection of ulcers/intection

- Offer pharmacotherapy and referral to local evidence based programs for tobacco cessation if patient has any active tobacco use
- Initiate pharmacotherapy (eg. buprenorphine-naltrexone for opiate use disorder, selective serotonin reuptake inhibitor for major depression) or request psychiatry consultation for untreated mood or substance use

Barriers to care. Mitigate social factors likely to impede the patient's adherence to treatment (see Table 5)
